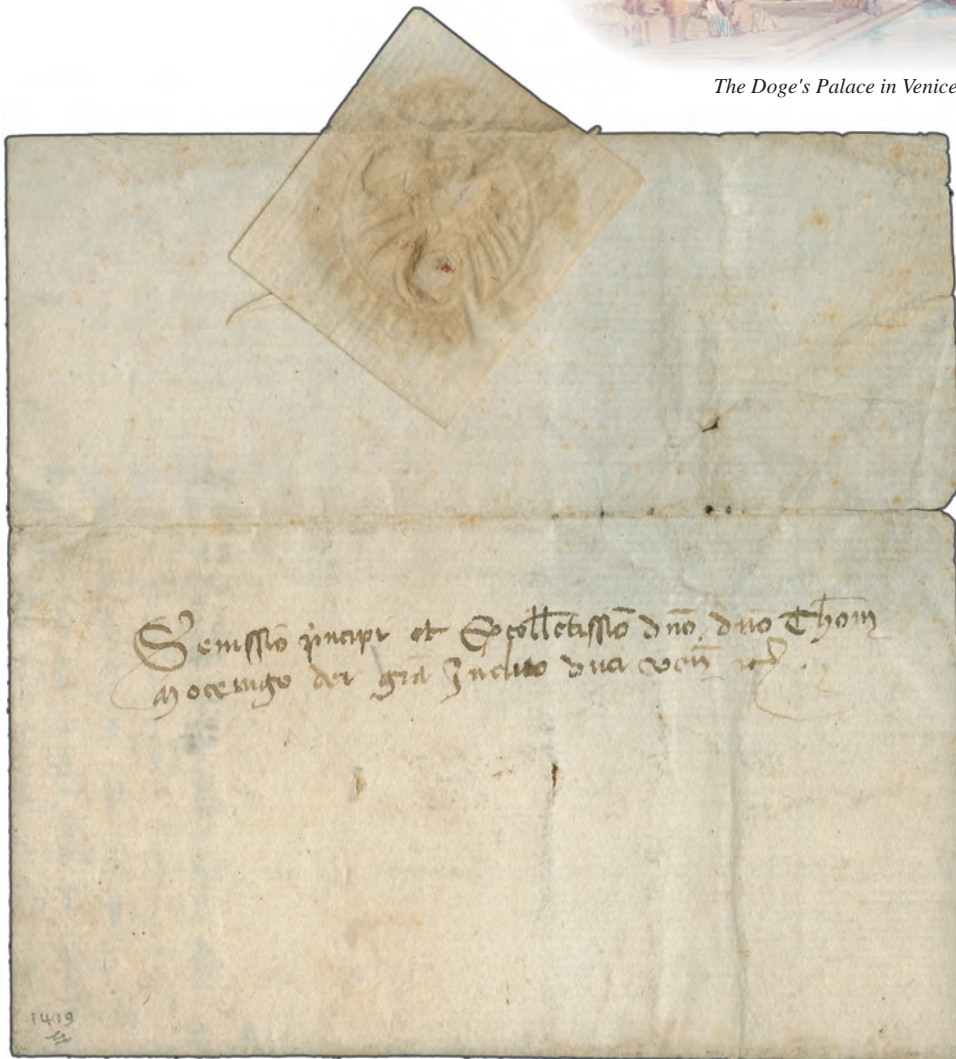

- 6501** 1419: Entire letter from Corfu to Venice, addressed to Nicolo Caragiani with outstanding embossed seal showing the Venetian Winged Lion placed over the reverse of the entire created from one piece of paper being cut and folded (a wonderful piece of origami), possibly for decorative and certainly for security reasons. An exceptional entire of great beauty for a letter of this period.

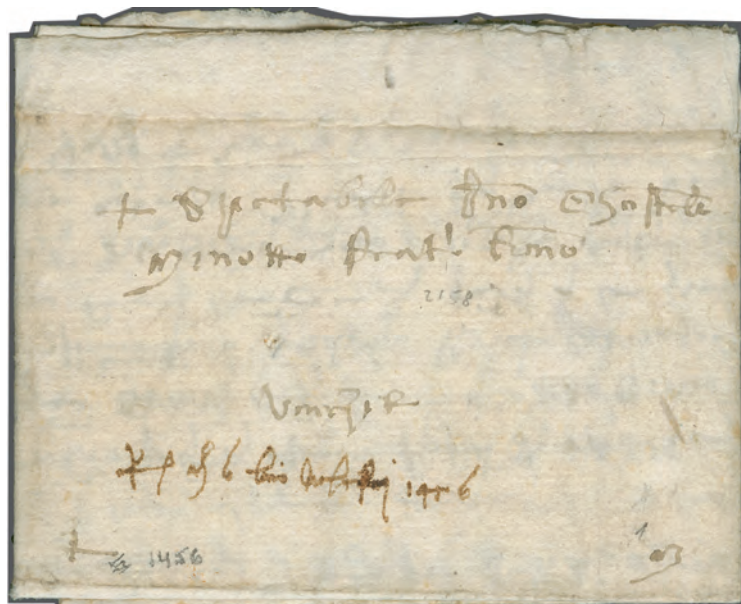

6502 1419: Entire letter from Corfu to Venice, addressed to Tommaso Mocenigo (1343-1423), Doge of Venice from 1414 until 1423, with large albino embossed seal complete on reverse, showing the 'Winged Lion' of Venice and addressed "*Serenissimo principe et excellentissimo domino, domino Tommaso Mocenigo dei gratia inclito duci Venetorum*". Unusually on paper at this period rather than parchment or vellum, minor soiling but exceptionally rare - believed to be the earliest letter known either to or from the Ionian Islands in private hands.

Note: The letter dates from a victorious year for Venice, defeating the combined forces of the Patriarch of Aquileia and the Emperor Sigismund, and signing a treaty with the Ottomans after their defeat at the Battle of Gallipoli in 1416.

- 6531** 1807 (Sept 7): Letter written to Général Clarke, dictated at Meneval and signed by **Napoleon Bonaparte** at base, concerning Corfu "The French and Italian troops at Corfu have to be part of the Army at Naples until new orders. They will be fed and paid by the Military chest of the Kingdom of Naples", with a follow-up to these instructions at base concerning the Paymaster Gherardini's presence on Corfu. The French text transcribed accompanies the lot, the letter signed at base "**Nap**" by Napoleon.

6532 1808 (May 21): Three and half page letter dictated and signed by Napoleon Bonaparte at Meneval to Général Clarke, concerning Corfu - "You will find a report on Corfu which will make you realise the necessity of your intervention concerning this island. Général Donzelot has raised his budget to 1 million a month... Corfu is not the only place in France on my mind...". The letter states how to reduce costs and measures to be taken added at lower left. French transliteration accompanies the lot. Signed clearly at base with "Nap" signature. Rare.

6533 1810 (Nov 26): Letter dictated by Napoleon Bonaparte at Meneval, to the Duc de Feltre, concerning Corfu - "to write with the utmost vigour to the King of Naples to urge him to continue the supplies to Corfu. Inform him that I will hold him responsible if Corfu would be short the slightest commodity and that the possession of that island is more important to him than to France, and that I will not accept that where I have stationed 30'000 troops. 10'000 would be at risk to die from hunger and my army would be dishonoured...". French transliteration accompanies the lot. Signed clearly at base with "Nap" signature. Rare.

- 6535** 1814 (May 6): Entire letter written from Parga, Greece by Sir Charles Gordon to Plato Petrides, Inspector of Colleges on Zante, struck in transit with superb circular "ISOLA DI SANTA MAURA" in red with rate "4" (pence) inserted in manuscript. Contents of the letter include: "I understand Capt. Angelo and the Navy are trying to persuade Donzelot to surrender Corfu which is not likely he will, they landed so often that he said if they came again, he would make them prisoners...It is said the General is there, if so I shall see him soon. It is feared the Austrian Army is coming from Venice to take Corfu. You know the former has surrendered...". Donzelot, commander of the French garrison at Corfu held on until he surrendered on 24 June 1814 under instructions from King Louis XVIII. The other six islands were in British hands: Zante had been occupied by the British since 4 October 1809 and Santa Maura since 16 April 1810.
